By car

Patient/visitor car parks are open and normal charges apply, but space is limited and there is no on-street parking nearby. If you need to wait in your car for a period of time, please make sure you have water to drink, especially in hot weather.

From the east:

M40 junction 8 or 8a, A40 then A420 to Headington and follow signs.

From the north:

M40 junction 9, A34 then A40 northern ring road, turning off for Marston (B4150), then towards Headington and follow signs.

From the south and west:

Approach from the A4142 eastern ring road and B4495 towards Headington and follow signs.

Parking

There is ANPR in the NOC's visitor car parks. Payment machines in the car park take card and contactless payments, and the machine in the hospital entrance takes card, cash or contactless payments. If you leave without paying, you will receive a Parking Charge Notice (PCN).

There is free motorcycle parking to the left of the Tebbit Centre, in front of the Oxford Gait Laboratory.

Blue Badge holders please register your vehicle registration number with the NOC Reception or email ANPR.Parking@oxnet.nhs.uk

Parking for Orange or Blue Badge holders is free of charge.

Accessible parking and areas for setting down and collecting patients are available close to entrances.

Patients who attend regularly for treatment over a prolonged period of time, and visitors to long-stay patients or relatives of patients in critical care, may be entitled to discounted or free parking.
